Head	Inspects mouth**, nose**, and assesses facial area (1 point) Inspects and palpates scalp and ears (1 point) Checks eyes: PEARRL** (1 point)	3		
Neck**	Checks position of trachea (1 point) Checks jugular veins (1 point) Palpates cervical spine (1 point)	3		
Chest**	Inspects chest (1 point) Palpates chest (1 point) Auscultates chest (1 point)	3

- Failure to take or verbalize infection control precautions

 Failure to immediately establish and maintain spinal protection

 Failure to provide high concentration of oxygen

 Failure to evaluate and find all presented conditions of airway, breathing, and circulation (shock)

 Failure to appropriately manage/provide airway, breathing, hemorrhage control or treatment for shock

 Failure to differentiate patient's needing transportation versus continued on-scene survey
- Does other detailed physical examination before assessing & treating threats to airway, breathing & circulation
